Analyse the elements of a web page	I can identify the elements of a web page and understand how it is organized in order to find the hyperlinks and contents that interest me.	I can make the difference between a website and web 2.0 tools (social media or any other platform). I can navigate between pages and sections of a website or a social platform and find the information I need.	I can compare how the information is structured and articulated in different sites and social platforms, evaluating which ones are easier to navigate, complete and exhaustive.
EXAMPLES	<p>I can explain what a website is. I can access a website in different ways: typing its URL address properly in the search bar, using a junior search engine or by clicking on a hyperlink, and I can browse the site.</p> <p>I can explore a specific website to about heat energy, and follow a path clicking on hyperlinks, understanding the organisation with menus and finding information on webpages and on the homepage.</p> <p>I know that underlined words that change colour when I mouse over them, are links to other websites. I right click them to see which web page they refer to before clicking them when I don't trust a hyperlink.</p>	<p>I can understand the structure of a URL address of a page and identify the author or the institution.</p> <p>Just by reading the webpage address, I can identify if it's the homepage or a specific page of the website.</p> <p>I can explore the different sections and pages of a social platform (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, etc.) in which heat energy is discussed, and understand how they are structured and how to find information.</p> <p>When I search the Internet on a recommended site, I can explore the pages of other sites and social media in the links offered by the site, distinguishing them from each other and returning to the starting site.</p>	<p>I understand the different elements composing the URL address. I can identify a secured page.</p> <p>I can critically evaluate among the various social sites and pages which contain more complete information on heat energy and appropriate to the level of my research.</p> <p>When I search among the links offered by a social page or a site, I can critically evaluate the useful ones, distinguishing them from those that direct to pages with unreliable information, or advertisements, or to paid services.</p>
